We are delighted to announce a brand new family gallery showcasing work by the Award winning Smallfilms duo of Peter Firmin and Oliver Postgate. They created iconic children's programmes such as Bagpuss and The Clangers from studios near Canterbury.

The gallery celebrates the huge output of Smallfilms from small rural roots and gives fascinating insights into early, pre-CGI animation. The partnership and the films produced received much recognition including Doctorates for Oliver, Peter (and Bagpuss!) It also generated a considerable output of books, comics and other merchandise over the years, examples of which are included in the exhibition.

This permanent exhibition has been created in close conjunction with the Firmin and Postgate families.

This exhibition with key input from the volunteers, features the significant, interesting (and largely unseen) finds of the project along with personal reflections from the volunteers.




Kent's ONLY Roman Museum
